## THIS ADDENDUM IS FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING THE FOLLOWING CHANGES OR CLARIFICATIONS:

**1. Question:** Can we receive an organizational chart of roles within the warehouse that includes the number of associates and clerks in the warehouse by location?

Answer: Please see attached document titled 1411821646 Addendum 2 – Org Chart and Roles.

**2. Question:** Can we receive data on hours worked in the warehouse without cost or names? The intent is to understand the man hours worked in the warehouse.

**Answer:** We currently do not have any data that provides the hours worked. For simple calculations we have 13 FTE's without including our foreman that are guaranteed 8 hours per day. This equates to 27,040 per year.

**3. Question:** How often do associates have to work overtime? Is there a seasonality to the workforce?

**Answer:** Very little to none outside of emergency call out work afterhours. The estimate is 3-5 days per year.

**4. Question:** Does JEA have a temporary labor policy?

**Answer:** Yes, but the warehouse does not utilize temporary workers.

**5. Question:** Can we receive a job description and qualifications for warehouse associates? Are they all forklift certified?

Answer: Please see attached job description documents titled 1411821646 Addendum 2 – Stores Working Foreman and 1411821646 Addendum 2 – Inventory Control Technician. All employees are forklift certified.

**6. Question:** Who is responsible for cycle counting? (Associates, Managers, Accounting?)

**Answer:** Associates perform cycle counts and managers verify adjustments made.

7. Question: Does JEA ever have 3rd parties count or audit their inventory value? If so, what is the frequency?

Answer: No.

**8. Question:** What physical security measures does JEA have in place for inventory?

**Answer:** Only warehouse associates and approved JEA employees have badge access to warehouse.

**9. Question:** Can JEA share their safety ratings within the warehouse?

**Answer:** N/A

**10. Question:** What active safety management programs do they have in place? Ergonomics, Forklift, HAZMAT, racking and storage procedures?

Answer: Safety management programs are in place for fall protection and forklift.

**11. Question:** Can JEA share their latest fire safety plan?

**Answer:** N/A

**12. Question:** Is there a documented housekeeping or 5S program?

Answer: No.

13. Question: How are returns managed from the field? Is there a SOP?

**Answer:** N/A

**14. Question:** How are supplier quality alerts managed? Is there a SOP?

**Answer:** N/A

**15. Question:** What role(s) are authorized to make inventory adjustments? Is there a threshold value?

**Answer:** Office support associates and supervisors make adjustments up to \$500. Any adjustment over that threshold will need manager approval.

**16. Question:** Can JEA share the results of the last 3 cycle counts?

17. Question: Is there a documented guideline on what products can be stored outside and length of time?

Answer: No.

**18. Question:** Does JEA have any inventory with a shelf life? Is it tracked within Oracle?

**Answer:** Yes, however it is not tracked in Oracle.

**19. Question:** Can JEA clarify the ABC Class within the item by org spreadsheet?

**21. Question:** Can JEA share the Oracle database relationship tables for inventory, organization and location?

**22. Question:** Does or has JEA used Understanding License Plate Setup (oracle.com)?

**Answer:** Yes, JEA currently has LPN's applied to all outbound and inbound pallets.

**23. Question:** Is it possible to get an export of the location table without inventory?

**24. Question:** Can we get the make/model of the Zebra Barcode Scanners?

Answer: New bin/location labels are made in house.

**26. Question:** Can JEA provide examples of pick sheets and cycle count sheets?

**27. Question:** Does the scanning system provide a time stamp for scanning?

Answer: Yes.

**28. Question:** Is there a process or guidelines for putaway (overstock, pallet locations) within Oracle?

**Answer:** No.

**29. Question:** Are there SOPs and on-board training for Oracle?

**Answer:** Yes, but they are very limited.

**30. Question:** How many licenses and users does JEA have for Oracle? Are there any restrictions with the current modules and subscription.

Answer: N/A.

**31. Question:** Does the system support different picking strategies like wave, batch, and zone picking?

Answer: Yes.

**32. Question:** Are there any delays or bottlenecks caused by the WMS in processing orders?

**Answer:** Yes. For example, there are too many steps to complete and ship order. It is standard system that allows you to just pick orders.
