	<p>Original Award: 05/06/2021 For additional Information Contact: Eddie Bayouth</p> <p>The purpose of this contract amendment is to exercise the two (2) renewal options for this contract for distribution transformers and increase the contract amounts of three (3) awardees, two (2) of which will include a ratification amount.</p> <p>The contract increases are a result of historic levels of demand and compressed supply, resulting in JEA purchasing additional supply from additional sources with inflationary impacts. JEA's original award was approximately \$30.8M. Given JEA's need to react to supply constraints along with inflationary impacts JEA saw approximately \$79.2M in additional costs to date in transformers purchased through this award. JEA's risk mitigation strategy included adding additional sources of supply through both short term spot buys, as well as leveraging relationships with existing suppliers to ensure long term supply continuity. This includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •awarding Gresco work for both single phase pad-mount transformers (452 units) and small kVa three phase pad-mount transformers (110 units) in the amount of \$7,503,760.00 of which all will be a ratification. •awarding Tri-State additional funds to cover additional single-phase pad-mount units beyond original bid plans to date (2410 units), as well as awarding them a backup supply for JEA of pole-mounted transformers (795 units), and three phase pad-mount transformers (200 units) to date plus funds to cover additional planned purchases in the amount of \$32,269,867.03; \$21,184,665.97 of this amount will be ratification, which consists of the full \$10,360,388.00 in three phase units as a ratification, the full \$4,307,678.80 in pole mount units as a ratification, and \$6,516,599.17 in single phase pad-mount units of the requested \$17,601,830.23 is a ratification. •awarding Wesco additional funds to cover pole mounted units which were added in previous awards as a backup supply, given allocations set by the primary supply, which now makes up a majority of contract purchases (3408 of the total 5973 units) to date which are slightly less than the three year estimate (7010 units); as well as additional funds to cover three phase pad-mount transformers (1140 units) which to date are far beyond the original bid plan (914 units) and are now supplied by three different manufacturers Hitachi, Camtran, and Eaton as a reaction to allocations implemented by Hitachi. There are no ratifications for this supplier. <p>Due to rising costs, higher lead times and the supplier allocation programs, it is currently in JEA's best interest to issue Renewals for supplier consistency and stronger relationships. Therefore, JEA intends to exercise both one (1) year renewals. The contract increase reflects usage for the next six (6) months which will allow JEA's planning department to calculate the remaining forecast through the remaining term.</p>

Uplift of the wet well in relation to the concrete slab has caused a break of one of the discharge piping lines within the wet well. This condition can lead to a potential sanitary sewer overflow (SSO).</p> <p>The scope of the work includes demolishing the existing pump station and construction of a new pump station. Petticoat-Schmitt was selected as the contractor, due to their experience with similar pump station rehabilitation projects.</p> <p>The cost of the repair has been reviewed by the business and deemed reasonable when compared to similar pump station repairs.</p>

	<p>Advertised: 01/18/2024 Opened: 02/21/2024 Three (3) Proposals Received For additional information contact: Darriel Brown</p> <p>The scope for this service includes providing services for restoration of cement concrete in City, County and FDOT roadways, rights of way and easements including the replacement of curbs and gutters free of standing water; meter box, manhole and valve jacket adjustments and replacements.</p> <p>At Proposal Opening, JEA received three (3) Proposals. One of the proposers, GEC Trucking & Construction, Inc., withdrew their proposal based on currently having a contract for this service in the North & West Territory. The solicitation required a different vendor for the South/East territory. Another proposal, from 1st Choice Engineering Construction & Development LLC, did not meet the Minimum Qualifications due to not having the required experience as a prime contractor and was subsequently disqualified. The remaining proposal from HG Concrete, having been deemed responsive, was evaluated and scored.</p> <p>HG Concrete is the incumbent for this service and has performed well during the current contract. The business requires that the service territory is divided between North & West and South & East as no single vendor has the capacity to manage the total territory service demands on both sides of the river. The North & West Territory is split between two vendors: H Trent and GEC Trucking.</p> <p>The new pricing represents a 34% increase over the current contract for the South & East Territory. For a comparison, pricing in the North & West Territory is cumulatively 19% lower than new price for the South & East Territory. The BAFO round negotiation resulted in a price reduction of 2.82% or \$132,472.75.</p>

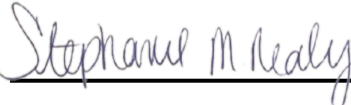

<p>For additional information contact: Dan Kruck</p> <p>The scope of work for this project includes the replacement of the top two rings and decks and the existing two east and west silos at the Buckman WRF. Repairs also include the existing silo on site being used for dry sludge storage at the Buckman WRF. CST is the original equipment manufacturer (OEM) of the silos and the repairs must be made by the OEM. JEA negotiated a 10% discount in the cost of the work.</p> <p>This contract was originally awarded informally. Three items have been previously authorized and paid for under this contract that were not part of the original quote. These three items have brought the contract total over the formal procurement threshold resulting in this ratification request. The first item is the cost of payment and performance bonds that were not factored into the CST cost proposal. JEA requires these bonds in accordance with State statute for this type of work. The second is cost of shipping needed parts. The cost of the shipping was unknown at the time of the proposal. JEA agreed to pay the actual shipping cost when the costs were known. These first two costs were inadvertently approved by Procurement prior to bringing to the Awards Committee. Going forward, Procurement will update its process to track informal awards that are close to the formal Procurement threshold. Lastly, the third ratification cost is for additional crane rental and operator costs. The additional crane rental was required due to the East silo hopper inspection findings.</p> <p>The requisitions were approved by the business unit Manager, and subsequently approved at the Director level.</p> <p>Discussion/ Action: Clarification was requested regarding ratification. Expenses incurred due to additional work performed due to damages found that needed to be repaired quickly. It was noted that additional damages were found when making these repairs, so an additional change order will be needed. The awards committee made note that they don't want to see that one as a ratification since we know it will be coming and is needed.</p>

<p>Originally Awarded: 03/30/2023 For additional information contact: Halley Stewart</p> <p>This Award requests a ratification and partial 11 month contract renewal for the sheltered 1411059446 Facilities Landscaping Maintenance services contract with an original award date of 03/30/2023, to align the two sheltered and one open market landscaping contracts with a 04/01/2025 start date. This extension will support those alignment efforts.</p> <p>Prior to the most recent renewal, Eagle Lawn Care requested a decrease in the number of assigned sites and identified six (6) sites to be removed from their contract due to staffing constraints. Originally, the decision was made to award those sites to the next lowest bidder RZ Service Group LLC under the original solicitation. However, the cost of services in the amount of \$159,840.00 was deemed unreasonably high by the facilities team based on historical CPI increases and facility's budget. JEA requested pricing from J & D Maintenance and Services, who provided a price of \$71,562.00. This represents a 55% cost avoidance in the amount of \$88,278.00 for the same sites quoted by RZ Service Group LLC. J & D's pricing for the relief sites is a 31% increase from Eagle's current pricing. Facilities deemed this pricing reasonable.</p> <p>The final price negotiation with J & D Maintenance and Services includes a dollar ratification to RZ Service Group LLC to continue landscaping services in the amount of \$2,960.00, while negotiations were finalized.</p> <p>It should be noted that this award amends the renewal Award from 04/18/2024 for Freedom Landscaping and Eagle Lawn Care. As noted, negotiations were still underway to cover sites that Eagle Lawn Care could no longer support.</p> <p>The complete history for the increases/decreases and renewal to date for the vendors are listed under the amendment section of the agenda.</p> <p>Discussion/ Action: Clarification was requested regarding ratification, Eagle Lawn care unable to perform all of the sites. The decision was made to go to the next low bidder, RZ Services to see if they were able to pick up the work. Through negotiations, their rates came back too high, so negotiations started with the next low bidder which was J&D Maintenance. The negotiated cost with J&D Maintenance was 55% lower than RZ Services so the decision was made to award to J&D for cost savings. During the negotiations, we needed someone to services those areas, and since we had negotiated rates with RZ Services and they had the capacity to do the site, we asked them to jump in for one mow while we finished negotiations. The ratification includes \$2,960 to RZ Service for their one time mow, as well as the contract expired during negotiations so it covers the gap of three weeks to continue services</p> <p>Discussion Participants: Ted Phillips, Chrissy Nunziato, Jenny McCollum</p>

Please find below our proposal for the above referenced project. Our price is based on plans provided by Mckim & Creed, dated January, 2024. No addendums or revisions have been received. This proposal is based on PSCC performing both the pump station renovations and temporary bypass pumping work, not one without the other.

Temporary Bypass Detailed Description of Work :

1. Set up bypass pumps on stabilized surface at existing grade.
2. Demolish and replace asphalt road, sidewalk and concrete curb as needed for bypass suction.
3. Erosion Controls
4. Restore to original condition the area where pumps are located
5. Line stop and wet tap on existing 6" force main.
6. Create opening in existing manhole for temporary bypass suction pipe.
7. Temporary Fencing
8. MOT as needed
9. JEA will be responsible for all work associated with bypass telemetry and SCADA.
10. Furnish and install bypass system complete with suction and discharge piping.

Temporary Bypass Clarifications:

1. No permits are included.
2. JSEB participation is not included.
3. Per JEA request the existing pump station control panel will be used for a period of time to operate the pump station while waiting on delivery of the new panel. This will require a second bypass pump mobilization.
4. No rehab or inspection of existing manhole in street except to repair temporary hole for bypass suction pipe.
5. Sheet C-300 shows the existing FM as 4", but Sheet C-303 shows it as 6". We are relying on Sheet C-303 to be correct for proper bypass operation.

7. This proposal is for 100% redundancy. If 200% is required, we will need to revise the proposal.
8. PSCC will maintain the pumps and furnish fuel.
9. Pricing below for the temporary bypass systems include a duration of 4 months. The lump sum price includes one time charges such as mobilization, pump system setup, asphalt & concrete work, tie-in & tapping to existing force main, temporary fence, MOT, etc.
