1	Original Award: 05/06/2021 For additional Information Contact: Eddie Bayouth The purpose of this contract amendment is to exercise the two (2) renewal options for this contract for distribution transformers and increase the contract amounts of three (3) awardees, two (2) of which will include a ratification amount. The contract increases are a result of historic levels of demand and compressed supply, resulting in JEA purchasing additional supply from additional sources with inflationary impacts. JEA's original award was approximately \$30.8M. Given JEA's need to react to supply constraints along with inflationary impacts JEA saw approximately \$79.2M in additional costs to date in transformers purchased through this award. JEA's risk mitigation strategy included adding additional sources of supply through both short term spot buys, as well as leveraging relationships with existing suppliers to ensure long term supply continuity. This includes: 1 **awarding Gresco work for both single phase pad-mount transformers (452 units) and small kV a three phase pad-mount transformers (110 units) in the amount of \$75,503,760.00 of which all will be a ratification. **awarding Tri-State additional funds to cover additional single-phase pad-mount units beyond original bid plans to date (2410 units), as well as awarding them a backup supply for JEA of pole-mounted transformers (795 units), and three phase pad-mount transformers (200 units) to date plus funds to cover additional planned purchases in the amount of \$32,269,867.03; \$21,184.665.97 of this amount will be ratification, which consists of the full \$10,360,388.00 in three phase units as a ratification, the full \$4,307,678.80 in pole mount units as a ratification, and \$6,516,599.17 in single phase pad-mount transformers (140 units) which to cover pole mounted units which were added in previous awards as a backup supply, given allocations set by the primary supply, which now makes up a majority of contract purchases (3408 of the total 5973 units) and are now supplied by							6/10/2021 - total \$3,303,281.97 Stuart C. At Proposal Opening, JEA received three (3) Proposals. One of the proposers, GEC Trucking & Construction, Inc., withdrew their proposal based on currently having a contract for this service in the North & West Territory. The solicitation required a different vendor for the South/East territory. Another proposal, from 1st Choice Engineering Construction & Development LLC, did not meet the Minimum Qualifications due to not having the required experience as a prime contractor and was subsequently disqualified. The remaining proposal from Ho Concrete, having been deemed responsive, was evaluated and scored. HG Concrete is the incumbent for this service and has performed well during the current contract. The business requires that the service territory is divided between North & West and South & East as no single vendor has the capacity to manage the total territory service demands on both sides of the river. The North & West Territory is split between two vendors: H Trent and GEC Trucking. The new pricing represents a 20% increase over the current contract for the South & East Territory. For a comparison, pricing in the North & West Territory is cumulatively 19% lower than new price for the South & East Territory. The BAFO round negotiation resulted in a price reduction of 2.82% or \$132,472.75. DISCUSSION/ ACTION: The reason this one was moved to the Regular agenda was to discuss the low bidding competition for these services. Three (3) Proposals received on date of opening. The decision was made to go to the next low bidder, RZ Services to see if they were able to pick up the work. Through negotiations, their rates came back too high, so negotiations started with the next low bidder which was J&D Maintenance. The negotiated cost with J&D Maintenance was 55% lower than RZ Services so the decision was made to award to J&D for cost savings. During the negotiations, we needed someone to services those areas, and since we had negotiated rates with RZ Services and they had the capacity to do the site, we asked them to jump in for one mow while we finished negotiations. The ratification includes \$2,960 to RZ Service for their one time mow, as well as the contract expired during negotiations so it covers the gap of three weeks to continue services

Please find below our proposal for the above referenced project. Our price is based on plans provided by Mckim & Creed, dated January, 2024. No addendums or revisions have been received. This proposal is based on PSCC performing both the pump station renovations and temporary bypass pumping work, not one without the other.

Temporary Bypass Detailed Description of Work:

- 1. Set up bypass pumps on stabilized surface at existing grade.
- 2. Demolish and replace asphalt road, sidewalk and concrete curb as needed for bypass suction.
- 3. Erosion Controls
- 4. Restore to original condition the area where pumps are located
- 5. Line stop and wet tap on existing 6" force main.
- 6. Create opening in existing manhole for temporary bypass suction pipe.
- 7. Temporary Fencing
- 8. MOT as needed
- 9. JEA will be responsible for all work associated with bypass telemetry and SCADA.
- 10. Furnish and install bypass system complete with suction and discharge piping.

Temporary Bypass Clarifications:

- 1. No permits are included.
- 2. JSEB participation is not included.
- 3. Per JEA request the existing pump station control panel will be used for a period of time to operate the pump station while waiting on delivery of the new panel. This will require a second bypass pump mobilization.
- 4. No rehab or inspection of existing manhole in street except to repair temporary hole for bypass suction pipe.
- 5. Sheet C-300 shows the existing FM as 4", but Sheet C-303 shows it as 6". We are relying on Sheet C-303 to be correct for proper bypass operation.
- 6. This proposal is being offered using a bypass system which includes two diesel pumps.
- 7. This proposal is for 100% redundancy. If 200% is required, we will need to revise the proposal.
- 8. PSCC will maintain the pumps and furnish fuel.
- 9. Pricing below for the temporary bypass systems include a duration of 4 months. The lump sum price includes one time charges such as mobilization, pump system setup, asphalt & concrete work, tie-in & tapping to existing force main, temporary fence, MOT, etc.

Pump Station Renovations Detailed Description of Work

- 1. Demolition
- 2. Erosion control
- 3. Landscaping, grassing and irrigation
- 4. New fencing
- 5. Temporary fencing
- 6. Clean out wetwell for liner inspection.
- 7. Liner inspection by Spectrashield.

- 9. Curb and sidewalk replacement as necessary
- 10. Bollards
- 11. Electrical work
- 12. Instrumentation and controls.
- 13. Remove and reposition existing pumps. Include new 90 degree ells, guide rails, lifting chains and brackets.
- 14. Remove and replace grout fillets at wetwell bottom.
- 15. Remove existing wetwell top. Replace hatch.
- 16. Install new manhole drop in wetwell.
- 17. Remove and replace existing discharge piping, valves and accessories as indicated.

- 3. No concrete inspection, destructive testing or rehabilitation of wetwell is included. See separate pricing below.
- 4. No existing liner removal is included. See separate Spectrashield pricing below.
- 5. No new liner installation is included. See separate Spectrashield pricing below.
- 6. Existing pumps and power cables are presumed to be in good condition and will be reinstalled. Cost for replacing these is not included.
- 7. PSCC cannot guarantee that the scope of work associated with this proposal will solve the problem with the wetwell floating. PSCC cannot be responsible for any future uplift or station failure.
- 8. The flow meter has been eliminated from the scope of work.
