

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The purpose of the Request for Proposal (the "RFP") is to contract two Auto transformer manufacturers for a forward looking, 7+ year plan to support replacements and exp slots to ensure supply. The longer term contract is required as substation transformer lead times are 3+ years. JEA evaluated the companies based on price and experience. For the longer term contract price of responsive and responsible proposers.

When this was originally awarded, there were 6 Auto Transformer slots forecasted for these contracts. Original award noted that these contracts will be brought back to the a additional slotted transformer projects in the later years of the contract as budgets and funds allow. This increase is to cover additional substation projects that have been iden currently being awarded with a zero dollar value, as the prospective project need date for the transformer where Prolec GE is lower priced forecast in 2032.

The transformer prices in this bid are trending to follow the Large Specialty Transformer producer price index. This PPI for transformers when this scope of supply was last 429.6 (81% increase), which is reflected in the pricing received.

Contracts have a price adjustment, which allows price adjustment through manufacturing release, or typically around 6 months prior to shipment.

This increase includes 5 Auto Transformers with the MVA/Voltage/Quantity seen below:
